When searching for colleges, it's critical to check graduation rates. Paying for college is hard enough without adding a fifth or six year to the tab! And yet most college students do not graduate in four years.

## Nationwide Graduation Rates

Here are the nationwide graduation rates as compiled by the federal government:

### FOUR-YEAR GRADUATION RATES

Public colleges and universities	33%
Nonprofit private colleges and universities	53%

### SIX-YEAR GRADUATION RATES

Public colleges and universities	57%
Nonprofit private colleges and universities	65%

These graduation rates are based exclusively on students who start out as full-time freshmen. The federal grad rates do not include students who begin college part time.

### HIGH COLLEGE GRADUATION RATES

Not surprisingly, the most elite schools, which primarily educate wealthy students, enjoy the highest four-year grad rates. The parents of the students attending these schools are much more likely to be able to cover the costs of a bachelor's degree and watch their children graduate in the traditional eight semesters.

Another explanation for high grad rates is that elite schools only accept exceptionally qualified students, who have the academic ability to earn a bachelor's degree on time.

## Reasons for Lower Graduation Rates

1. **Money.** In contrast to the experience of wealthy students, plenty of other students have to drop down to part-time, leave school at least temporarily, or transfer to a cheaper institution because they can't afford to continue.
2. **Some students aren't prepared for the rigors of college.**
3. **Students can't enroll in the classes they need to graduate on time.** This is a huge, pervasive

- problem, for instance, at the California State University campuses, which represent the nation's largest university system. The four-year grad rate for the 23 CSU schools is just 19%!
4. **Universities don't make timely graduation an institutional priority.** They fail to provide meaningful support, including academic advisors, academic support, adequate financial aid and having enough courses.

## THE INSTITUTIONAL EXCUSE

Schools with low grad rates would like you to believe that it's the students' fault for failing to graduate on time, but this is largely a cop-out!

Universities with students from similar demographics can experience wildly different graduation outcomes. Among otherwise similar institutions, according to the [Education Trust](#), a highly-respected think tank, graduation rates can vary by as many as 20 percentage points.

### ***What's the explanation for this?***

Successful universities make it an institutional priority to increase the chances that all their students, regardless of their socio-economic background, graduate on time!

Education Trust has been dogged about encouraging schools to take grad rates seriously, and it regularly applauds universities that focus on making sure more of their students earn diplomas. Here are examples of universities, pulled from a recent Education Trust report, that have been working hard on graduation outcomes for minority and first-generation students:

## What You Need to Know

You can't only find significant graduation differences among schools that attract the same kind of student bodies, but that also sport the same price tags. You shouldn't assume, for example, that all expensive, selective universities will generate high graduation rates. You can see this by checking the four-year grad rates of the following private universities in California that attract similar types of affluent applicants:

<b>Chapman University</b>	59%
<b>University of San Diego</b>	67%
<b>Loyola Marymount University</b>	67%
<b>Pepperdine University</b>	70%
<b>Santa Clara University</b>	77%

The cost of attendance at both Chapman and Santa Clara cost \$70,000. Santa Clara, however, has a considerably higher graduation rate. This is NOT an isolated example. Clearly, parents and teenagers need to be asking questions about graduation rates!

## How Grad Rates Are Calculated

The federal government has gotten grief over its methodology for calculating graduation rates. In addition to only calculating the grad rates of full-time students, the methodology drops the ball when students transfer. When a student leaves for another college, that student is treated as a non-graduate of his or her original institution.

Consequently, when there are a significant number of students who transfer out, the grad rate will be lower than it actually is for those students who stay. Of course, it's not a good sign when a lot of students leave prematurely.

## What You Need to Do

1. Check the graduation rates of schools, including by ethnicity, race and gender, at [College Completion](#), which is a microsite of *The Chronicle of Higher Education*.
2. You can also check graduation statistics at [College Results Online](#), which is a handy website sponsored by the Education Trust.
3. If a graduation rate is unsatisfactory, ask a school for explanations. Find out how some students manage to graduate in four years.
4. Don't just rely on explanations about graduation rates from a college staffer. Also ask students at the college for their take.
5. Consult the lists below that contain the four- and six-year graduation rates of hundreds of private and state colleges and universities. I pulled the lists together by using federal data compiled by College Completion.
6. Always check a school's freshmen retention rate. This figure will tell you how many students stayed for their sophomore year. You can find a school's freshmen retention rate on the [College Results Online](#) website.
